

## What to do at each centre



- \* Arrive on poolside at least 5 minutes before the session starts.
- \* Swimmers completing pre-pool should be on poolside 10 minutes before the session start.
- \* Bring all normal kit – goggles, water bottle, swimming hat, etc.
- \* Take shoes off before going onto poolside.
- \* No phones to be used at all in changing facilities.
- \* All swimmers to be careful walking through car parks, as some of these are very busy.

<b>Kingswood Leisure Centre</b>	Land training – meet in the sports hall in the basement. Swimming – meet on the balcony above the changing room area for pre-pool. - for learner pool trials please wait by the gate below the steps near the learner pool. - for main pool trials please wait by the gate at the deep end of the main pool.	Beside the wall in the sports hall  Lockers – do not leave bags or belongings in cubicles	Cubicles alongside main pool for squad swimmers and behind the shower area for Learn to Swim & Swim Academy.  Squad swimmers should not use the small group changing room, or the Learn to Swim changing area (behind the showers). <b>Winterbourne Academy</b>	Land training – wait outside the door to the sports studio on the left-hand side after the reception desk in the main building  Swimming pool can be accessed via a side door. Boys on the left-hand side and girls on the right-hand side.  The pool can be accessed out of the opposite side of the changing room to the entry door from the entry corridor.	None. An overflow car park is next to Winterbourne Library (next door to the school car park), with a path that connects the two car parks next to the astro pitches.
<b>Bath University</b>	Meet on poolside	On poolside or use lockers	Changing rooms are unisex with cubicles and are shared with other clubs and members of the public	Spectator seating on poolside or seats in the main area of the Sports Training Village. \*Badminton School has asked us to remind families that swimmers must be appropriately covered up on arrival and exit.

\*\*Masters swimmers and families **MUST** park off-site for the duration of the session. The drop off area is available for use at the start and end of sessions. Those people who are waiting for swimmers may return to the car park just before the session end, walk along the gravel path to the pool door to meet your swimmers 2 minutes before the session ends. You must remain in this area. These are conditions of our hire, so must be adhered to.
